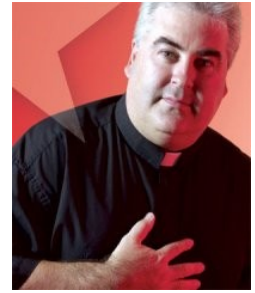

Enjoy the rest of your summer and may our Lord and Savior remain in your hearts.

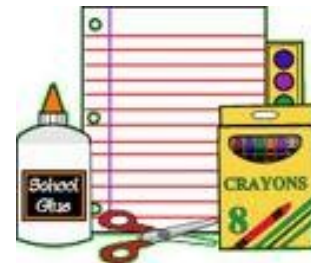

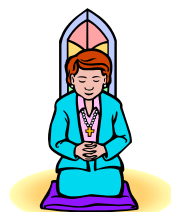

## Name Badges



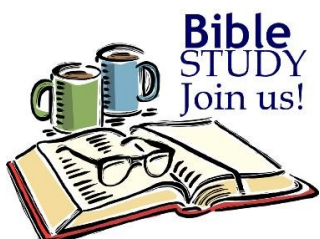

Father Mark's bible study is open to everyone, even non-parishioners who might like to attend. It's a great way for people of different faiths to come together, so keep inviting your friends!

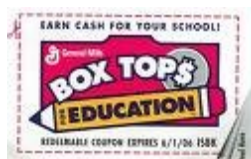
