

### Parish News

The 2013 Cadillac Backpack Scramble Charity Golf Tournament was a soaking success this year. While the rain brought the players in a little early, the tournament atmosphere was bright and sunny! The sold-out group of 144 players and the dozens of banquet-only diners filled Hacienda Hills Restaurant with a brilliant, joyous buzz. The dinner was incredible as usual at the Backpack Scramble and the raffle and door prizes were top shelf once again. I'm happy to report over 20,000 items were collected at our tournament with a retail value of over \$35,000. This brings our total items collected over the past three years to over 110,000 items with a retail value of over \$200,000 and we're just getting started.

Next year, please mark your calendars for tournament dates of May 1 & 2, 2014, with a banquet tentatively scheduled for Sunday afternoon, May 4. The tournament will be held at Hacienda Hills Country Club again, but we're shooting for 400 golfers, as we will be using all 27 holes for the two-day golf part of the event. There will be an ultra fun and fantastic banquet event and we're working on lowering the price of the banquet only portion, so more people will be able to come. The players' donation will be \$100 per person and the banquet will be less than the usual \$50 per person. The monetary proceeds collected to date have been distributed to homeless programs for personal care products and also used to purchase a 2011 Cargo Van for deliveries. You may have noticed my face on such van. This is a blessing to all of us in many ways, but most importantly, we glorify God in the work we are doing for His most vulnerable children.

If you want to reserve an early spot, so you won't be disappointed when we sell out, please contact Susan Hilt from our parish. Susan's phone number is 353-307-2129 and she handles the registration portion of the tournament. Again, there will be three Cadillacs put up as Hole-in-One prizes on both days. We're confident that one of you will win one this time around!



Our Proprietary Sponsor for 2014 is The HoneyBaked Ham Co. of Lady Lake, FL, so you can only imagine how much fun this is going to be! We are looking into a giant pig roast bbq banquet, with all kinds of wonderful eats. We will be organizing the tournament with many ways to win lots of incredible prizes, and looking into starting a new tradition with "HoneyBaked Master" type jackets for the winning golf team. The most important thing in all, is that the homeless kids win that day. We are hoping to collect over 50,000 items from players, banquet only diners and the general public. Villagers outside the tournament brought in over 12,000 items on the day this year, and our contest for who brings in the most items will have multiple winners, with a big first place prize! So start saving up on items! In the meantime, please continue to bring in deodorants

and feminine pads as they are desperately needed in all counties to help the teenagers get through the summer months.
