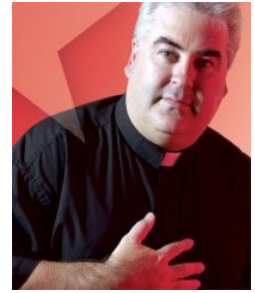

Blessing of the Animals

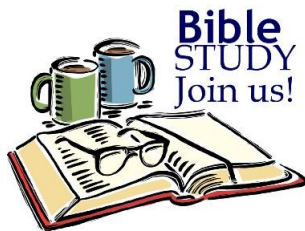

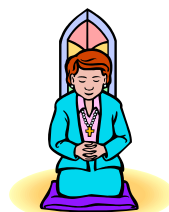

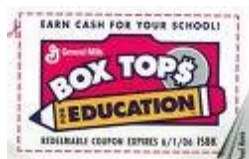
