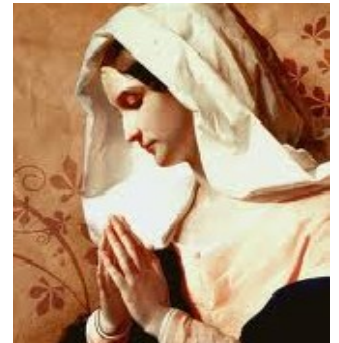


## Ladies Adoration Society
