#### 70th Anniversary of death, Prime Bishop Francis Hodur

Francis Hodur was born near Krakow, Poland. He emigrated to the U.S. in 1893. That same year, he was ordained as a priest. On the March 14, 1897, Father Hodur became pastor of St. Stanislaus Cathedral, Scranton, PA. On Sept 29, 1907, Father Hodur was consecrated bishop by Old Catholic Bishops in Utrecht, Holland. Choir practice has been cancelled until further notice.




### **Ladies Adoration Society**

#### YMS of R MEN'S RETREAT

The first ever Young Men's Society of Resurrection will be held on March 16-17-18, 2023 at The Retreat at Silver Springs in Ocala, just 13 miles from St. Paul. This is a full-service retreat facility run by The Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). The pictures to the left show the entry to the Retreat Center, the dining hall, one of the conference rooms, and one of the lounge areas. The Retreat also has sleeping quarters, an outdoor worship area, and a fire pit for outdoor relaxation and camaraderie. The cost will be approximately \$160 for the three-day event.

We will start off on Thursday, March 16th at 11:00am at the St. Paul Bible study with Father Mark. Following that, the group will go to lunch at Pasta Faire. We then proceed to Silver Springs and check in. This will allow a little down time. Dinner will be at the Retreat in the dining hall. Following dinner, the first session will be held in one of the conference/classrooms. Relaxation and socializing will follow.

Friday morning starts with breakfast, followed by a Holy Mass conducted by Father Mark and Deacon Gail. A shortened session (#2) will follow before lunch. Sessions #3 and #4 will be held Friday afternoon followed by dinner. The day ends with social time around the fire pit (weather permitting).

Saturday kicks off with breakfast in the dining room. From there we will have a final session that will last till about 11:30am. The retreat will be concluded with prayers. The retreat ends at 12 noon.

Father Mark and Deacon Gail will be working on the program for the sessions. Suggestions are welcome.

While this is a YMS of R event, any male member of St. Paul in not only welcome but encouraged to join us. This will be a special event that will help solidify your faith in our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. If interested, please see Deacon Gail.
