

The Young Men's Society of Resurrection (YMS of R)



The Emblem of the Polish National Catholic Church

THE SYNOD OF SCRANTON, HELD IN 1904, ADOPTED THE EMBLEM FOR THE POLISH National Catholic Church.



The central object is the book, above which rises the bright sun of freedom, light and warmth, surrounded to the right by the cross and to the left by the palm.

Emblazoned on the streamer beneath, are the words: "Truth, Work, and Struggle."

THE BOOK—Symbolizes the communication between God and man by the revealed Word.


THE CROSS—Is the symbol of faith and the highest sacrifice.

THE PALM—Represents victory and peace.

THE SUN—Is the sign of light, religious freedom and creative energy.

THE MOTTO—Truth, Work, and Struggle is the maxim by which Christian principles are incorporated into life.

Christianity is a forceful and positive religion which establishes its just laws and the Kingdom of God by rugged and fearless moral strength. "The kingdom of heaven suffereth violence and the violent take it by force." *Matt. 11:12.*
