From the Desk of Father Mark:

Dear St. Paul Parish family and children of God,

All glory to the Lamb of God! It is my prayer, hope and wish that all of you have been and remain safe and sound. Outside of the gospel message, I have additional good news. I have formulated a plan for church and communion with an emphasis on safety protocol. Please respect and abide by this plan. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact Father Mark, cell: **352-454-2644**.

Beginning Sunday, September 13, 2020, those wishing to drive to the church on Sundays and receive the Holy Eucharist may do so, with the following conditions:

1. You will have watched and participated in the video online Mass earlier in the morning in your home before coming to the church. Mass should be available to view beginning at 6am each Sunday at stpaulfl.com (*Our service for each Sunday is professionally pre-filmed, edited and broadcast in High Definition 4K with professional sound quality*).
2. You have no fever, sore throat or symptoms of any virus, infection or cold.
3. You will have sanitized your hands before coming into the church. You will please bring your own sanitizer (The bathroom will be open for anyone wishing to wash their hands with soap and water).
4. You will put a mask on before entering the church.
5. You will not touch anything or anyone inside the church. Just please stand in line in the center isle approximately six feet behind one another and maintain social distancing.
6. The Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist will be administered orally and the distributor will sanitize his fingers before each person receives.
7. Once receiving the Holy Eucharist, please depart to your left, then down the side isle to the back and exit the church. Please, no congregating in the parking lot before or after the reception of the Holy Eucharist.
8. Non parish members are welcome to receive the Holy Eucharist also.

Again, please note the Holy Eucharist will be offered each Sunday, beginning **Sunday, September 13, 2020 from 9am – 12Noon**. You can view the Mass online earlier by going to the parish website: stpaulfl.com (please ensure you have enough time to watch the Mass and then drive to the church):
